

Image Editing Vocabulary



Crop Removal of unwanted outer areas from the outside edge of an image.



Aspect Ratio The ratio of the width to the height of an image or screen. A fixed aspect ratio is where the proportions of the width and height stay the same in relation to each other.

Filters

Adding an effect over an image. Different filters have different affects on the image. For example, below is a blur filter. Filters are like looking at an image through different lenses. Filters can be used to **sharpen**, **blur**, **smooth** or add **grain** effects to an image.





Colour Editing

Colour **saturation** is used to describe the intensity of colour in the image. A **saturated image** has overly bright colours.

Temperature means to add warmer colours such as yellows and reds, less temperature means showing more white.

Vibrance makes the parts of the image that are not colourful more colourful.

Tint can reduce darkness.



Light Editing

Brightness is the amount of light in an image. Too much light can make an image look faded. **Exposure** can also add more light too.

Contrast increases the difference between dark and light making an image look stronger but less colourful.

Highlight can bring out the brightness of an image whereas **shadows** brings out the darkness.
