What is in each level?

The levels are as follows. Please refer to this when your child has received their certificate for completing a level as this will show you which number facts they have to focus on next.

How can you help your child at home?

- Ensure they are practising the appropriate number facts at home.
- Remind your child that you can complete addition in any order, so as soon as you have learned that
 - 6 + 1 = 7 you have also learned the answer to 1 + 6 = 7.
- Learn the same fact in different ways. For example if 70 + 30 = 100 then 70 + ... = 100; + 30 = 100; 70 + 30 = ...; 20 = 17 + ...
- Have number facts displayed around the house magnetic numbers on the fridge are great!
- Say the number facts out loud or to a rhythm or tune (there are CDs available with all sorts of dance beats).
- Use computer websites and software programs or tablet / iPad apps learning always seems more fun when there is a computer involved.
- Spot patterns and relationships i.e. doubles are all even numbers.
- Matific games will also help your child master these facts.
