

Word	Definition
building	A structure that someone has built, such as a house.
bungalow	A bungalow is a house without any upstairs rooms.
caravan	A caravan is a vehicle like a small house that can travel from place to place.
change	When you change something, you make it different.
dislike	If you dislike something, you do not like it.
flat	Something that is flat is smooth and has no bumps on it.
future	The future is the time that will come.
hear	When you hear something, you notice it through your ears.
home	Your home is the place where you live.
house	A house is a building where people live.
improvement	If there is an improvement in something, it gets better.
key	A list of symbols used in a map or table.
landmark	An object on land that you can easily see from a distance.
like	If you like something, you think it is nice.
map	A map is a drawing of a town, a country, or the world.
route	The route that you follow is the way you go to get to a place.
see	When you see something, you notice it with your eyes.
smell	When you smell something, you notice it through your nose.
special	Something that is special is different and more important than other things.
symbol	A symbol is a sign which stands for something or means something.
