Safeguarding & Wellbeing



Pupil **safety** & **well-being** is the foundation of everything we do at Widmer End. All staff are trained in safeguarding and are all First Aid Trained. In 2018 we were one of the first schools in the country to gain the Nurturing Schools Quality Award.

Pupils with medical needs, such as asthma / nut allergy: parents will be asked to complete a health care plan and to bring medicine to be kept in school. Notes will be sent home following a bump to the head or teeth. Children will also wear a sticker back to class to make the Teacher and LSA aware.
