We have arranged an exciting School Trip to Woolley Firs Environmental & Education Centre, to take part in the 'Fancy Plants & Tremendous Trees' programme, in conjunction with our Science Curriculum. The required contribution is **£31** per child. Please confirm attendance and permission via ParentPay, which accepts debit and credit cards as well as bank transfers. The deadline for this is the 15th April. Please bear in mind that we must cover costs to ensure all children can attend the trip, or it will have to be cancelled.
