Year 6 Ancient Greeks URE Museum Trip - Tuesday 12th November

We are delighted to let you know that we have arranged for our Year 6 class to attend a brilliant trip to the University of Reading Museum, to enhance learning about the Ancient Greeks. The children will discover all about this important and culturally sophisticated civilization through the material evidence they left behind. The session is structured in three main parts:

Firstly, there is a session on the formation of the museum and the role of archaeologists and curators in the development of our knowledge about ancient people and how they lived. The children will then have the chance to handle ancient objects and apply the concepts that they have discussed. Finally, the children will get creative with the museum's vase animations and get the chance to re-enact their own interpretation of some of the mythical scenes on the pots.

We need a number of adult helpers to accompany the class on the trip, and we welcome your participation. If you are able to attend, please contact the school office.

The required contribution towards the cost of the trip will be **£20**, which includes a charitable donation to the museum. Please confirm attendance and permission via ParentPay, by the **15th October**. ParentPay accepts debit and credit cards as well as bank transfers. Please bear in mind that we must cover costs to ensure all children can attend the trip, or it will have to be cancelled.
