Year 6 Lincolnsfield 'Children At War' Trip - Wednesday 5th February 2025

We are excited to let you know that we have arranged for our Year 6 class to take part in a brilliant trip to the Lincolnsfields Children's Centre, for a 'Children at War' day.

The 'evacuees' get a chance to visit a 1940s house to discover that life was not as easy as it is nowadays. They will visit the Dig for Victory garden complete with Anderson Shelter and discover what they had to do in the event of an air raid. The visit to the Blitz Building will lead them to a public shelter as the planes fly overhead and bombs are dropped. There may be a chance to go back to school to see how lessons and treatment of children have differed over time.

Each of the sessions are led by a member of Lincolnsfield staff or one of their committed volunteers who have personal stories from World War 2, dressed from that time period to enhance the role play.

Children will need to:

- Wear full school uniform
- Bring a nut-free packed lunch (no glass or cans please)
- Be open to the teaching style of the WW2 'teachers'!

We need a number of adult helpers to accompany the class on the trip, and we welcome your participation. If you are able to attend, please contact the school office.

The required contribution towards the cost of the trip will be £27. Please confirm attendance and permission via ParentPay, by the 8th January. ParentPay accepts debit and credit cards as well as bank transfers. Please bear in mind that we must cover costs to ensure all children can attend the trip, or it will have to be cancelled.
