## **School Uniform Policy**

School officially		
For all children		
Winter (From October half-term - Easter)	<ul> <li>Charcoal grey skirt / pinafore or trousers</li> <li>White collared shirt (KS2) / polo shirt (KS1)</li> <li>Royal blue school sweatshirt or cardigan*</li> <li>Black or grey socks / tights</li> <li>School tie (KS2 only)</li> </ul>	
Summer (From Easter - October half-term)	<ul> <li>Charcoal grey shorts or trousers</li> <li>White, short-sleeved collared shirt (KS2) / polo shirt (KS1)</li> <li>Royal blue and white gingham dresses / skirt and blouse / culottes</li> <li>Royal blue school sweatshirt or cardigan*</li> <li>Black, grey or white socks</li> </ul>	
Shoes	<ul> <li>Black leather shoes</li> <li>Heels, trainers, boots and open-toed sandals are not suitable for school</li> </ul>	
PE	<ul> <li>Black shorts, skort, jogging bottoms or leggings (with or without logo*)</li> <li>White T-shirt (with or without logo*)</li> <li>Royal blue PE hoodie*</li> <li>Black or white trainers</li> <li>Sport socks</li> </ul> Children can still wear their existing PE kit if it still fits. The change to the new PE kit will be a gradual transition over the next 2 years so please just replace the kit as you need to. You might consider purchasing a school PE hoodie rather than an additional school jumper, to cover the 2 PE days.	
Additional		
Jewellery	<ol> <li>Jewellery is unsuitable for school wear as it is easily lost or damaged and can cause injury to wearers and others.</li> <li>Only a small, plain watch (no smart watches) and / or small stud earrings are allowed.</li> <li>Earrings are to be taken out on PE days or covered in tape.         For KS1 children this should be done at home, before school.         KS2 children should be able to do this themselves before their PE lesson.</li> <li>Jewellery worn for religious reasons must be explained to and agreed with, in writing, to the Headteacher before wearing them.</li> </ol>

Hair (all children)	<ol> <li>All hair styles should be smart and tidy</li> <li>Hairstyles / cuts should not be a distraction to other children. Tramlines / designs / patterns are not permitted.</li> <li>Long fringes should be clipped back.</li> <li>Shoulder-length or longer hair should always be tied back neatly with a simple, small blue or white hair band or 'bobble'.</li> <li>Any other hair accessories should be in school colours.</li> <li>Beaded braids or braids with cotton / material weaves are not encouraged but will be discussed on an individual basis.</li> <li>Hair should be of natural colour.</li> </ol>
Bookbags	<ul> <li>Reception &amp; Key Stage 1 children need a Widmer End book bag* to carry their belongings.</li> <li>Key Stage 2 children need a backpack*</li> </ul>
Coats	<ul> <li>Coats (including lightweight summer raincoats and winter coats) should preferably be in a neutral or school colour.</li> <li>'Hoodies' are not to be worn in place of coats.</li> </ul>
Other	Sun hats and caps will only be worn during periods of sunny weather.
