

Spelling Shed Word lists – Group 1 – Autumn term 1

Spelling rules	Words
Week 1 Week commencing: 16/9/24 The /f/, /l/, /s/, /z/ and /k/ sounds are usually spelt as ff, ll, ss, zz and ck if they come straight after a single vowel letter in short words	puff, fluff, bell, doll, grass, kiss, buzz, fizz, clock, back
Week 2 Week commencing: 23/9/24 The /k/ sound is spelt as k rather than as c before e, i and y. The /nk/ sound found at the end of words and usually comes after a vowel	bank, honk, tank, pink, think, kit, skin, mask, sketch, basket
Week 3 Week commencing: 30/9/24 Words ending '-tch'. The /ch/ sound is usually spelt as 'tch' when it comes after a single vowel letter	catch, kitchen, hutch, ditch, match, fetch, switch, witch, patch, watch
Week 4 Week commencing: 07/10/24 Adding s and es to words (plurals). If the ending sounds like /s/ or /z/, it is spelled as -s. If it forms an extra syllable, then it is spelled as -es	flowers, boxes, lunches, brushes, churches, cars, dishes, dogs, foxes, boats
Week 5 Week commencing: 14/10/24 Adding the endings -ing and -ed to verbs. If the verb ends in two consonant letters (the same or different), the ending is simply added on	looking, buzzing, jumping, helping, fizzing, looked, buzzed, jumped, helped, fizzed
Week 6 Week commencing: 21/10/24 Words with the prefix 'un-' and the suffixes '-er' and '-est'	fresher, quicker, higher, hardest, darkest, unhappy, undo, unload, unfair, unlock
