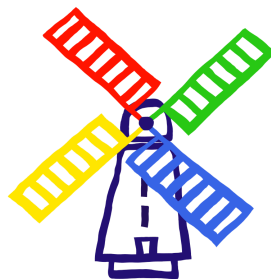

For all children	
Winter (From October half-term - Easter)	- Charcoal grey skirt / pinafore or trousers - White collared shirt (KS2) / polo shirt (KS1) - Royal blue school sweatshirt or cardigan with Widmer End logo - Black or grey socks / tights (not sports socks) - School tie (KS2 only)
Summer (From Easter - October half-term)	- Charcoal grey shorts or trousers - White, short-sleeved collared shirt (KS2) / polo shirt (KS1) - Royal blue and white gingham dresses / skirt and blouse / culottes - Royal blue school sweatshirt or cardigan with Widmer End logo - Black, grey or white socks (not sports socks)
Shoes	- Black leather/faux leather shoes, no flashing lights - Heels, trainers, boots and open-toed sandals are not suitable for school

PE	• Black shorts, skort, jogging bottoms or leggings (with or without logo) • White T-shirt (with or without logo) • Royal blue Widmer End logo PE hoodie • Predominantly black or white trainers, no flashing light, no multicolours • Sport socks
Forest School	• Full PE Kit Children are required to come to school wearing their full PE kit. This ensures they are appropriately dressed for active outdoor learning and reduces the need for changing on-site. Additional weather-appropriate items (e.g., waterproofs, hats, gloves, wellies) may be brought as needed. Please note that during the Summer term, children must still wear long sleeves and long bottoms for Forest School sessions.

Jewellery	• Jewellery is unsuitable for school wear as it is easily lost or damaged and can cause injury to wearers and others. • Only a small, plain watch (no smart watches) and / or small stud earrings are allowed. • Earrings are to be taken out on PE days or covered in tape. ○ For KS1 children this should be done at home, before school. ○ KS2 children should be able to do this themselves before their PE lesson. • Jewellery worn for religious reasons must be explained to and agreed with, in writing, to the Headteacher before wearing them.
Hair (all children)	• All hair styles should be smart and tidy • Hairstyles / cuts should not be a distraction to other children. Tramlines / designs / patterns are not permitted. • Long fringes should be clipped back. • Shoulder-length or longer hair should always be tied back neatly with a simple, small blue or white hair band or 'bobble'. • Any other hair accessories should be in school colours. • Beaded braids or braids with cotton / material weaves are not encouraged but will be discussed on an individual basis. • Hair should be of natural colour.
Makeup and cosmetics	• Make-up and cosmetics are not considered appropriate or consistent with our school uniform. The school does not permit such products to be worn by any children, Nails should be kept natural and of a suitable length for school.
Bookbags	• Reception & Key Stage 1 children need a Widmer End book bag* to carry their belongings. • Key Stage 2 children need a backpack*
Coats	• Coats (including lightweight summer raincoats and winter coats) should preferably be in a neutral or school colour. • 'Hoodies' are not to be worn in place of coats.

Other	• Sun hats and caps will only be worn during periods of sunny weather. • No sunglasses unless agreed with the class teacher or school office for medical reasons.

Please also note:

- Everything that comes into school must be clearly labelled with your child's name – including all clothing, bags, PE kit, water bottles and lunchboxes.
