



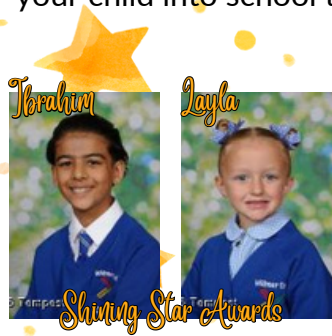
Dear Widmer End families,

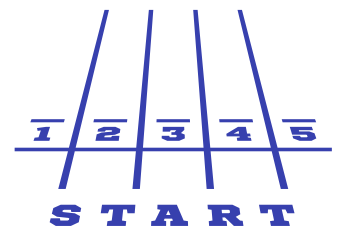

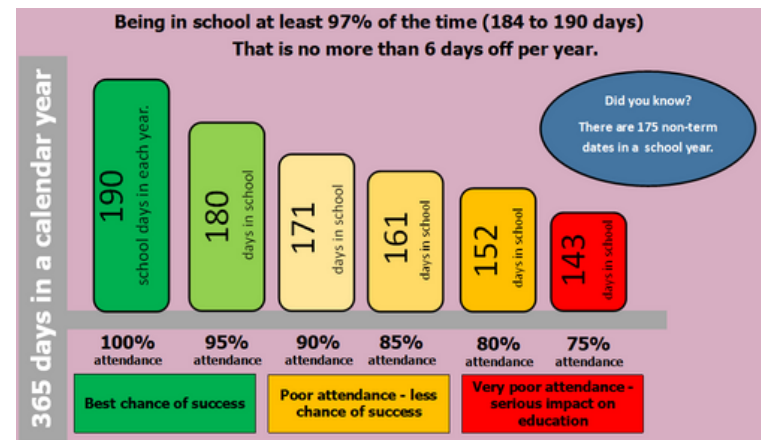
