



Application For Permission To Bring A Basic Mobile Phone Or Parent-Owned Location Tracker To School

From September 2026, pupils will not be permitted to bring smartphones or other internet-capable smart devices onto the school site, including for hand-in or storage. For the purposes of this policy, a smart device is any device capable of accessing the internet, applications or social media, regardless of whether these functions have been disabled, restricted or are not currently activated.

Exceptions will only be considered in exceptional circumstances where the device is essential to an agreed medical, SEND or safeguarding plan and prior written permission has been granted by the Headteacher.

I understand that this remains entirely my responsibility, even where the school provides a reminder.• I confirm that the tracker is intended to support my child's independent travel while helping our family delay smartphone ownership in line with the Guiding Digital Childhoods principles.• I understand that bringing an unauthorised device to school, or breaching any condition of approval, may result in confiscation and withdrawal of permission. |
